THE 15th ANNUAL KILLEEN OPEN PRO-AM TOURNAMENT RULES

- ENTRY FEE** - \$50.00 for adults (\$40 if paid by August 8); \$35.00 for youth, age 17 and below (\$25 if paid by August 8); \$20 for Special Olympians. Multiple entries accepted, but a bowler may cash only once. **Entries close 30 minutes prior to Squad Time.** For re-entry, deduct \$10 from original rate.
- AVERAGES** - It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average. All bowlers must have verifiable league averages or will have to bowl scratch.
RULING A - The average to be used shall be the bowler's highest 2010-2011 yearbook average based on a minimum of 21 games. Averages other than yearbook average requires secretary's verification. If a bowler does not have a 2010-2011 yearbook average, use the following in priority:
RULING B - 2011 Summer league average of at least 15 games.
RULING C - 2009-10 yearbook average.
RULING D - An entrant not qualifying under Rulings A, B or C must bowl with a 220 average.
- HANDICAP** - Handicap allowance is 80% of 220.
- FORMAT**
 - There shall be three divisions, adult, youth, and Special Olympians. Adults and youth bowlers may bowl on the same squad and on the same lanes.
 - There shall be a maximum of 5 amateurs and 1 professional for each pair of lanes.
 - The amateurs will bowl all three of their games on the same pair of lanes. The pros will move a pair of lanes to the right after each game so each amateur will have 3 pro partners.
 - Each bowler will bowl three games in 9-pin no-tap format, receiving a strike if 9 pins or better are knocked down on the first delivery.
 - The amateur's three game total, plus handicap, plus the combined scratch scores of each of the professional bowlers will determine the position standings. All professional scores will be scratch and shall be recorded as a minimum of 220 per game if the pro's actual pin fall is less than 220.
- PRIZES** - At least one in every 5 entries or major fraction thereof shall qualify for prizes. Cash prizes shall be awarded in the adult division and trophies or plaques shall be awarded in the youth and Special Olympians divisions. No current PBA members are eligible for any prize. Complimentary entrants shall be eligible for cash prizes ***if the prize fund portion of the entry fee (\$12.50) is paid.***
- RESPONSIBILITY** - Overall responsibility rests with the Pro-Am Tournament Director. The director reserves all rights, including the right to determine all questions of eligibility and all questions regarding the interpretation of rules.
